SISI member, Janet Wassmuth, Esq., presented the very moving scripted Prisoners of War (POW), Missing in Action (MIA), Veterans ceremony calling attention to the fact that not everyone returns home from wars and conflicts and asking us all to REMEMBER them and their sacrifices.

A small empty table is set for one with an empty inverted glass symbolizing that the missing veterans are not here to toast with us.
